

# FIRE & BUILDING REGULATIONS

## Exhibition Halls Specifications

Floor Loading	30 KN / sqm
Floor Finish	Floor Finish A concrete flooring the permitted floor loading stipulated by the venue owners must not be exceeded.
Concrete Ceiling Height	6m - 16m
Freight Entrance	4 X (7.3m W X 5.9m H) roller shutters per hall

## Fire Precautions

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- The materials used in the stand construction must be fire-retardant with a minimum flame spread rating of Class 2.
- Permanent false ceiling is not allowed (including cloth, leaves, etc). However, false ceiling of egg-box or mesh construction of non-combustible materials may be allowed. Approval must be sought from the Fire Safety and Shelter Department (FSSD) through the Organiser, and plans must be submitted at least six (06) weeks prior to the exhibition. Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Corridors leading to exits must be kept free of obstruction at all times.
- Under no circumstances should the fire alarm call points, fire hoses, fire extinguishers and exits be blocked or access to them be impeded by exhibition booths, partitions, exhibits or other objects.
- If construction of the stand involves welding, application to the FSSD and Hall Authorities must be made through the Organiser. If approved, a fireman must be hired to be on standby.
- No naked or open flame equipment is to be used in the exhibition hall without prior approval from the Organiser.
- The exhibition hall is equipped with fire extinguishers and fire sprinkler system. Exhibitors who require special types of fire extinguishers because of their exhibits must make all arrangements at their own cost for the provision of such equipment.
- Smoking is prohibited under the Smoking (Prohibition in Certain Places) Act. Any person who smokes within the facilities of the exhibition halls, restaurants, lounges or any enclosed air-conditioned places shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding S\$1,000.

## Building Regulations

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- No suspension is to be made from the trusses of the exhibition halls without written approval from the Organiser, or may any fixings be made to the structure of the building.
- No nails or screws shall be driven or holes drilled in the floors, walls, doors, pillars or other parts of the structure of the exhibition halls or any part of the building.
- The Exhibitor will not cause or permit any damage to be caused to the exhibition hall or alter or interfere with the building structure of the exhibition hall. The Hall Authorities will evaluate the damages and all charges for the repair shall be fully borne by the Exhibitor.
